

Instructions On fire safety rules for hotel guests

1. Read the evacuation plan, which is located in your room;
2. Remember how to contact the reception and accommodation service;
3. Do not use electric heaters that are not part of the equipment;
4. It is forbidden to operate electrical wires and cables with visible insulation;
5. When leaving the room, do not leave unattended household appliances included in the electrical network, including those in the standby mode (TV, Air conditioning, lighting lamps, chargers);
6. We remind you that it is dangerous to cover the included floor lamps, table lamps and oil radiator with combustible material;
7. Smoking in the building and in the rooms is strictly prohibited;
8. Smoking is allowed outside in specially designated places marked with the signs «Place for smoking»;
9. The use of fire in buildings and premises is prohibited;
10. It is inadmissible to bring and store explosive and fire hazardous substances and materials in the rooms;
11. Do not leave small children unattended and do not allow children to play with matches and lighters;
12. If you arrived in the building for the first time, try to remember well the location of the evacuation exits and stairs;
13. Check out the location on the floor of emergency exits;
14. Find the manual fire alarm button in the corridor or the staircase and learn how to use it if necessary.

In case of fire:

- * Immediately inform about the incident to the staff of the reception, indicating the floor, which burns and his name;
- * If possible, leave the room and close the door, follow the evacuation exit;
- * **DO NOT USE LIFTS.**
- * If smoke is in the room — **DO NOT STAND:** smoke and gas.
- * Leave the danger zone follow the instructions of the reception staff, Security staff.
- * If corridors and staircases are very smoke-fogged and You cannot leave the room, stay in your room, informing the reception about your name and the room number in which you are located;
- * If the door is hot or smokes penetrate from it – **DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR!**
- * A closed and well-sealed door can reliably protect you from a dangerous temperature.
- * To avoid smoke poisoning, close slots and vents with water-soaked towels of bedding;
- * Fill the sink with water. To extinguish the fire use the waste basket;
- * Cover your nose and mouth with a wet towel;
- * Do not open the window;
- * If the walls and doors of the rooms are hot constantly pour them with water, using a wastebasket;
- * When arriving the firefighters, go the window and give a sign about helping you
- * **FIRST OF ALL, KEEP CALM!**
